

ICIM2023 – HOW TO FORMAT AN ABSTRACTS

Below are instructions on how to format your Abstract before submitting via the online portal:

SUBMISSION PERIOD	December 12nd, 2022 – March 31st, 2023
LANGUAGE	English
MAXIMUM SUBMISSIONS PER AUTHOR	<p>An Abstract can only be submitted to one session topic.</p> <p>There is no limit to the number of different Abstracts you can submit.</p> <p>The corresponding author must be the presenting author (abstract submissions by co-authors will not be allowed); all authors of the abstract have to be listed, including their affiliations;</p>
ABSTRACT FORMAT	<p>Text Submissions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Number of words: 400 words (title, authors and institutions, and 3-6 keywords not included);• Authors and their organization affiliations must be included;• All images and graphs must be included in the Word Document;• Use single-line spacing in the text.
ABSTRACT LAYOUT	<p>NB: The file name of your submission should match the title of your abstract</p> <p>All Abstracts must clearly include the following elements within their structure in this order:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Introduction and objective• Methods• Results• Conclusions• Keywords
ABBREVIATIONS / ACRONYMS:	Should be spelt out in full when first mentioned, followed by the abbreviation or acronym in brackets.
NOTES	<p>Corresponding authors are responsible for the scientific correctness, the accuracy of their submission, including the grammar and correct spelling, as well as the names of authors and institutions.</p> <p>References are not allowed in abstracts.</p>
